### FREE INCOME TAX PREPERATION

Provided by I Have a Dream Foundation through the Iowa Center for Economic Success, prepare your taxes for free on these dates. You can drop your information off with a tax professional or stay for questions. Everything is completely confidential.

You will need to bring 1) proof of Identification, 2) SSN card, 3) proof of Insurance, 4) birthdates for all family members, 5) proof of childcare payment, 6) proof of income from all employers, 7) college tuition payments or student loan interest statements, and 8) previous year's tax return.

When your returns are ready, simply pick up your prepared tax return at <u>no cost</u> to your or your family and send it in!
